The New Mexico Film Office Announces “Be My Baby” to film in New Mexico

SANTA FE — New Mexico Film Office Director Nick Maniatis announced today that the feature “Be My Baby” produced by Real Grande Entertainment LLC will begin principal photography at the end of this month until mid-December in Albuquerque and Santa Fe.

The production will employ 55 New Mexico crew members, 15 New Mexico principal actors and over 100 New Mexico background talent.

The film is directed by Farhad Mann (“Twist of Fate,” “Hopeless Romantic,” “Fatal Memories,” “Fighting for Freedom”) and produced by Gilles Laplante (“Ties that Bind,” “Heart Felt,” “Manny Dearest,” “Underground Nightmare,” “Bloodsuckers”).

“We are very excited to embark on our first production in New Mexico. Everyone we have met and worked with thus far have proven to be highly proficient in their field, and have made us feel very welcome,” said Gilles Laplante. “We have a slate of films lined up for 2017 and hope that this experience will lead us to make their production home here in New Mexico.”

“Be My Baby” is the story of Danielle Matthews who kills her husband and goes on the lam with her infant daughter Cali. When the cops draw close, Danielle abandons the child but is caught and sent to prison, agreeing to give full custody of Cali to her estranged sister Nikki. But when Danielle is released from prison, she again teams up with her boyfriend to get Cali back from Nikki at any cost.
